

#### ABOUT KYRGYZSTAN


Kyrgyzstan is one of the Central Asian republics bordering Kazakhstan, China, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. It is a mountainous country, 93% of its territory is located at over 1000 meters above sea level. Lake Issyk-Kul in the north-eastern Tain Shan is the largest lake in Kyrgyzstan and the the second largest mountain lake in the world after Titicaca. The highest peaks are in the Kakshaal-Too range, forming the Chinese border. Peak Jengish Chokusu, at 7,439 m (24,400 feet), is the highest point and is considered by geologists (though not mountaineers) to be the northermost peak over 7,000 m (23,000 feet) in the world. Heavy snowfall in winter leads to spring floods which often cause serious damage downstream. The runoff from the mountains is also used for hydro-electricity.

The climate of Kyrgyzstan is a sharply continental climate with very hot summers and cold winters in the mountain regions. Approximately 247 days a year are shiny. The temperature in January varies between -4°-to-14°C; in july varies between +12°to+40°C. In winter warm clothes needed and in summer light clothes such as shorts and T-shirts are essential.

In Kyrgyzstan one can see the transition from the subtropical climate of the Fergana valley and semi-desert of the Chui and talas valleys to the eternal frost of the mountains. In the Valleys the wintertime is warmer than in the mountains. Because of this light clothes are appropriate in summer, but in winter, mediums to warm clothes are essential.




#### KYRGYZSTAN AS TOURISM




Ala-Archa Valley is situated in the highest part of the Kyrgyz Range of the grandiose mountain system of Tien-Shan, 35 km from Bishkek – the capital of the Kyrgyz Republic. "Ala-Archa" means "variegated Archa" from Kyrgyz. Ala - Archa is located on the territory of gorge. Natural Park is occupying about 20 hectares of territory, including such climate-landscape zones as subalpine, which surprising everytime there tourists. This Natural Park got his name because of the instant growing woods plant and creeping vegetation of Archa all along the gorge.

In Ala-Archa gorge were founded around 1100 types of plants, what arrange about 1/3 all of types of Kyrgyz flora. Animal world of Ala-Archa is rich and peculiar. Here we can meet a lot of field animals and birds, animals with interesting and unusual biology. Any types of hunting is forbitten in the territory of Natural Park.

Here everyone can breathe the fresh mountain air and sit under the shade of slim Tien-Shan firs observing the wonderful panorama of the glaciers around and snow-covered peaks, meet herds of ibex and mountain goats, visit mountain hut – the start place almost of every ascent. Guiding by your desire and physical condition you can choose different variants of walking, hiking and trekking that we worked out. All of them start from the former alpine camp, which is located in the fir forest zone on the altitude 2100 m above sea level.







#### ISSYK-KUL



Issyk-Kul is the largest region of Kyrgyzstan and its most popular tourist destination.

The region is situated around Lake Issyk-Kul, the world's second largest alpine lake, after Titicaca, 1600 m above sea level, 170 km long, 70 km wide and 695 m deep. "Issyk-Kul" means "hot lake" in Kyrgyz, as it never freezes. The mountains and the marine microclimate produce a wild, unique environment. The mountains surrounding the lake are a shelter for very rare animal species (snow leopard, cutter-loader, wild boar) and plants, such as the Tyan-Shan fir. Impetuous, violent rivers, starting from snow-white glaciers, carry their waters to the lake. In 2001 Issyk-Kul was designated by UNESCO as a Man and Biosphere reserve.

Issyk-Kul offers the highest, snow-capped peaks in the country; and the opportunity to trek, cycle, climb, ski, raft, windsurf, tour on horseback or just relax at one of the famous coastal resorts.

A large part of inhabitants are farmers. After the collapse of the Soviet Union, almost all industries ceased to exist. Main means of transportation is with horses and donkeys pulling wooden carriages. Due to the mild climate fruits grow in abundance, and trees filled with apricots, pears, apples and peach are inviting us to try the sweet and on the spot. As there are too many fruits anyway, nobody cares to let a passing by visitor steal a few. Towards the larger city of Karakol, peasants are also selling the sweetest and best quality of their fruits: a kilogram of apricots costs 1 Som (about 2 cents). Melons, dried fish from the lake, grapes and chestnuts are very popular here as well. Prices for us are unbelievably low. Still with an average monthly salary of 25 dollars, a kilogram of apricots at 2 cents must be expensive. Some dealers also buy in large quantities and transport the fruits over rough roads into 700 km close capital Bishkek or even further into Kazakhstan.



#### THE CITY BISHKEK





The capital, Bishkek, is situated in the Chui valley in the north of country, between the Talas valley in the west and the eastern Issyk-Kul region. It was founded in 1878 and originally was called Pishpek, which is the name of the wooden paddle with which the Kyrgyz make their Kymyz (Kumiss - fermented mare's milk), the national drink. Later, during the Soviet Union period, it was named Frunze after the famous Russian General Mikhail Frunze. At the time of Independence in 1991, it was renamed Bishkek.

The City has been influenced by the Russains from the beginning, and actually more or less built by them. Most of the buildings you see today are built in a typically Soviet architectural style, and the trees in the parks, boulevards and alleys are watered by a system of canals built by Russians. Those boulevards and parks make this a pleasant city to live in, as they provide total shade in summer, when temperatures may reach 40 degrees Celsius (105 F), and the open canal system also helps to keep the summer bearable, Bishkek is known to be one of the greenest cities in Central Asia as a result of the planning.

Bishkek cannot claim to be one of the major cities of the world. like London, Paris or New York. It is however, the Capital City of Kyrgyzstan and does have number of important and interesting buildings, monuments, Paris or New York, It is, however, the capital city of Kyrgyzstan and does have a number of important and interesting buildings, monuments, parks, museums, galleries, theatres and other places worth seeing or visiting. This is not meant to be an exhaustive guide to the city but simply a brief introduction to the city and its history

Like Kyrgyzstan generally, the climate is Continental-which means hot summers and cold winters. The average annual temperature is -1°C. The atmosphere is generally dry with rainfall occurring mostly is spring. There is an average of 322 days of sunshine per year. There are two rivers flowing through the city - The Alamedin and Ala-Archa - both tributaries of the River Chui. Also the grand Chui Canal flows through the city. The Kyrgyz-Russain institute for Distance Learning was created jointly with the modern Humanitarian University of Moscow, under auspices of the intergovernmental committee on knowledge propagation and adult education in CIS. Graduates of this Institute get diplomas from Higher Education of Kyrgyz Republic and the Russian Federation.

The Kyrgyz-Indian Institute for Distance learning was created jointly with the Indira Gandhi National Open University (India). Also, the European Resource center (IUK-Arnhem Business School, the Netherlands), American Resource Center (IUK-University of Michigan, USA), Education Information resource center (IUK-Bern University, Switzerland), Regional Academy of CISCO, INternational Telecommunication Union, Center of Higher Education Institutes intergration to the bologna process (IUK-EU) were created.


All lessons are conducted on western education standards at the IUK-credit hour's system. The IUK students have the opportunity to transfer from second and third year to the universities of the USA and Europe.



#### **Basic Medical Education**

General Medicine - 5 years of studies for school graduates with 12 years of educational experience (mostly for British Commonwealth citizens). This program is implemented with English as the language of instruction. The program in implemented with the use of integration and modules based, training technology introduced in Kyrgyzstan with the technical support of World Health Organization experts and through the application of credit hours system.

#### Post Graduate Studies - (Residency Program, 3 years)

#### Library

Like every higher education institution ISM has a library that contains a huge collection of Medical books. Latest foreign editions of commonly used books are available in sufficient numbers. New editions of books are regularly updated with WHO series and periodicals, in English and in Russain, and all the measures are taken for availability of books to every student. The library possesses a unique book stock (above six thousand items) including traditional and new information carrying mediums, among them there are books in the line of medicine: therapy, pediatric, oncology, dermatology, gynecology, histology, microbiology, pharmacology, orthopedic, etc.

#### STRUCTURE OF ISM

The International School of Medicine has a mobile and compact structure, allowing to give quick responses to any challenges of the time and to introduce innovative technologies in educational, scientific and medical performance. #### HOSTEL

ISM have separate Girls Hostel. A female warden in responsible for the safety of the girl students in the hostel. The entrance and exit of the girl's hostel has an extra inner gate to ensure extra security and safety of the female students. A representative of the the ISM. IUK student Parliament, i.e. the Girl's senator also resides in the hostel and helps other girl students with their problems and assists them whenever required.

#### Common details of hostel premises

A group of three or four students are allotted a room, according room size. This room is furnished with three beds, three side tables, three chairs, one large sized study table, and a cupboard, Pillows, Bed sheets, Mattresses, Quilts and Blankets are provided by the hostel in charge. Each room has a large window for easy ventilation. Every room has an automated heating device that runs 24x7 during the winter snow season to maintain optimum temperature in the hostel rooms. Each hostel floor has a set of toilets and bathrooms that have a regular 24x7 cold and hot water supply

A laundry and a press service operate in the ISM, IUK Hostel for the benefit of the students residing in the hostel. Workers have been appointed to collect dirty clothes from the students. was them and return back after ironing. This has saved the precious time of the students which thy can utilize for studies. Additional workers have been appointed to maintain cleanliness and hygiene in the ISM, IUK Hostel. Rooms are cleaned and wiped on a daily basis. Toilets and Bathrooms are also cleaned daily with antiseptics and detergent. Bed sheets, Pillow Covers and Quilts are changed Weekly twice. This enables extra hygiene and cleanliness which in line with the IUK Hostel Standards.













#### INDIAN MESS AT ISM

Food is the most important and the basic necessity of life. Keeping the necessity in mind, ISM has a special provision for food and catering to student needs through it mess/canteen.

This mess is run by Dr. Phani Bhushan Potu the ISM vide dean, (international students). The university's hostel has a canteen where Indian cooks work. Students have opportunities to enjoy the traditional Indian cuisine. However currently, the mess operates for Indian students only.

The Cook from India is a south Indian food specialist while the cook from North India excels in North Indian food. The Indian ISM mess has a variety of menu that includes chapatti, rice, vegetables, pulses, curd, sweets etc. Meals are served three times a day. There is a specified discipline in the ISM mess. Correct timings should be maintained by students.

ISM UIK has its own transportation facilities for students. There is a bus that transports students to educational centers that are located on the outskirts of Bishkek.

The Kyrgyz transport system is well organized with mini Buses, Buses and Trolley Buses, connection every part of Bishkek city. The cost to use public transport is 10 Kyrgyz Soms for Trolley Bus, 15 Kyrgyz Soms for Bus and 10 Kyrgyz Soms for Mini Bus. Taxis are also available at reasonable prices.







#### INDO-KYRGYZ RELATIONS

International Relations Department is a supporting structural unit of International School of Medicine This department deals with the establishment of relations with foreign universities and relevant scientific research institutions and educational centers. It spreads information about exchange programs and puts them into practice. The Department is also in charge of the minutes (protocols); arrangement of hosting delegations from foreign universities and organizations, development of collaboration with higher educational institutions of countries involved in Bologna Process, serving foreign students, supporting mobility process of students and other relevant services.

Kyrgyzstan in always having high diplomatic relation with Indian government since that time of U.S.S.R.













#### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The attraction and admission of foreign, prospective students is conducted in cooperation with official Representatives, having offical agreements with ISM and relevant authorities.

Agreements between ISM and Official Representatives include the following liabilities:

Promote Public relations in home country, check authenticity of students' documents, and guarantee that applicants have no other aims except for the aim to receive medical education while staying in the Kyrgyz Republic

Arrival and training expenses of foreign students at ISM include:

- Admission fee, tuition fee, hostel accommodation fee. These payments must be made according to ISM rules and procedures.
- Living expenses of foreign students in Kyrgyz Republic including food, extension of visa and registration fee as well as other
  expenses must be covered by students on their own, in compliance with ISM rules and procedures.

#### ISM Admission Requirements (necessary conditions)

- . Completed intermediate education, equivalent to secondary education of the KR.
- . 50% rating scores.
- Admission fee will not be refunded in case of any violation of the code of conduct of the ISM University.

#### Necessary documents (Originals):

- Certificate of completed intermediate education.
- · Passport with appropriate entry visa.
- · Medical reference- 086 form, (medical inspection can be provided in the Medical Center of the ISM).
- · Application form.
- 10 photographs (3x4cm).

#### Necessary documents when being transferred from other Higher Medical Institution:

- Certificate of completed intermediate education.
- · Academic reference from previous higher Medical Institution
- Extract from order on expulsion from previous Higher Medical Institution.
- Extract from order on expulsion from previous Higher Medical Institution.
- Certificate of Preparatory entry visa.
- Passport with appropriate entry visa.
- Medical reference 086 form, (Medical inspection can be provided in the Medical center of the ISM).
- · Application form.
- 10 photographs (3x4cm).





#### Passport and Visa Procedures

If you have decided to study at the International School of Medicine (ISM), you need to have the following when entering the Kyrgyz Republic (KR):

- Authorization on entry given on ISM application.
- · Consideration of request on visa support by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of KR during I month.
- . Entry visa can be given out in diplomatic representation missions and consular departments of KR, abroad or consular agency at the "MANAS" airport.

#### After you have arrived at ISM

- Your passport shall be registered by Ministry of Interior of KR within 5 days from the date of arrival, excluding holidays and weekends.
- Assistance in registration and visa extension.
- Passports must be presented to the Department of International Affairs, 1 month before the expiry of visa.
- Failure to meet registration and visa terms results in fine, set by Ministry of Interior of KR.

#### Deadline for admission of international students depends on the selected program: Fall semester-Until 5th October

- Sprint semester Until 5th February
- · Postgraduate studies During academic year
- · PhD studies During academic year
